




Quilt designed by Karen Bialik



Finished quilt: $61^{1}/2^{1} \times 80^{1}/2^{1}$

Fabric Requirements

2/3 yard (one panel) Dona-C3245 Peacock

1³/₈ yards Dona-C3248 Peacock

1/2 yard Dona-C3247 Beige

7/8 yard Studio-C3096 Taupe

1 yard Dona-C3246 Aqua

1¹/₂ yards Studio-C3096 Khaki

2/3 yard Dona-C3248 Peacock (binding)

5 yards Dona-C3248 Peacock (backing)

69" x 88" batting

Cutting

Note: This quilt has nine borders, numbered from the inside to the outside for easy reference.

From Dona-C3245 Peacock:

• Trim the panel to $23^{1/2}$ " x $42^{1/2}$ ". (If the panel measures slightly smaller than these measurements, it will be corrected when the first borders are added.)

From Dona-C3248 Peacock:

- Cut six 1¹/₂" x width of fabric (WOF strips). Sub-cut 160 $1^{1/2}$ " squares.
- Cut four 13/4" x WOF strips. Join the strips end to end using diagonal seams and sub-cut two 13/4" x 26" Border 1 top and bottom and two $1^3/4$ " x $42^1/2$ " Border 1 sides.
- Cut seven 4" x WOF strips. Join the strips end to end using diagonal seams and cut two 4" x 73¹/₂" Border 9 sides and two 4" x $61^{1/2}$ " Border 9 top and bottom.

From Dona –C3247 Beige:

- Cut one 3³/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut two 3³/₈" squares. Trim the remainder of this strip down to 3".
- Cut three 3" x WOF strips. Adding the trimmed strip from the previous cut to these three strips, join the strips end to end using diagonal seams and cut two 3" x 44¹/₂" Border 2 sides and two 3" x 25¹/₂" Border 2 top and bottom.

From Studio-C3096 Taupe:

- Cut one 3³/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut two 3³/₈" squares for Border 2 corners. From the remainder, cut two strips $1^{1}/2^{"}$ $\times 32^{1/2}$ " for Border 3 top and bottom.
- \bullet Cut fourteen $1^{1}/2^{"}$ x WOF strips. Join the strips end to end using diagonal seams and cut:
 - \sim Two 1¹/₂" x 49¹/₂" for Border 3 sides
 - \sim Two 1 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 55 $^{1}/_{2}$ " Border 5 sides
 - ~Two $1^{1/2}$ " x $38^{1/2}$ " Border 5 top and bottom
 - \sim Two 1¹/₂" x 71¹/₂" Border 8 sides
 - ~Two $1^{1/2}$ " x $54^{1/2}$ " Border 8 top and bottom

From Dona-C3246 Aqua:

- Cut two $2^{1}/2^{1}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty $2^{1}/2^{1}$ squares.
- Cut five 21/2" x WOF strips. Join the strips end to end using

diagonal seams and cut two 2¹/₂" x 51¹/₂" Border 4 sides and two $2^{1/2}$ " x $36^{1/2}$ " Border 4 top and bottom.

• Cut seven $1^{1/2}$ " x WOF strips. Join the strips end to end using diagonal seams and cut two 11/2" x 691/2" Border 7 sides and two $1^{1/2}$ " x $52^{1/2}$ " Border 7 top and bottom.

From Studio-C3096 Khaki:

- Cut three 61/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the following Border 6 strips:
 - ~One 61/2" x 271/2"
 - \sim One 6 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 26 $^{1}/_{2}$ "
 - ~One 61/2" x 211/2"
 - \sim One 6 $^{1}/_{2}$ " x 20 $^{1}/_{2}$ "
- Cut nine 2¹/₂" x WOF strips. Using the leftover fabric from above plus these strips, cut a total of $160 \ 2^{1/2}$ " squares.
- Cut three $1^{1/2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut eighty $1^{1/2}$ " squares.

From Dona-C3248 Peacock binding:

• Cut eight strips 21/2" x WOF.

Block Construction

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 1½" C3096 Khaki squares. With right sides

together, place a 1½" C3096 Khaki square on one corner of a 2½" C3246 Aqua square. Sew along the marked line. (figure 1) Cut away the extra fabric



1/4" beyond the stitching line and press the seam allowances toward the triangle.


(figure 2) Repeat on all four corners of the



C3246 Aqua square. Repeat to make a total of fig. 2 twenty Aqua squares. (figure 3)

2. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " C3248 Peacock fig. 3-Make 20. squares. With right sides together, place a 1½" C3248 Peacock square on one corner of a 2½" C3096 Khaki square. Sew along the marked line. Cut away the extra fabric 1/4" beyond the stitching line and press the seam allowances toward the triangle.


Repeat on an adjacent corner of the Khaki block. Make a total of eighty Khaki squares. (figure 4)




fig. 5-Border Star Block-Make 20.

3. Using the remaining $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Khaki fig. 4-Make 80.

squares and the squares made in steps 1 and 2, sew together a total of twenty 6½" Border Star blocks, shown in figure 5. 4. Sew four strips of

Border Star Blocks together: one of four blocks, two of five blocks and one of six blocks.

- 5. To make the star Border 6 sew the following C3096 Khaki strips to one end of the Border Star Block strips:
 - $\sim 6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $26\frac{1}{2}$ " to the four (top)
 - $\sim 6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to one five (bottom)
 - $\sim 6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $27\frac{1}{2}$ " to the other five (left)
 - $\sim 6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $21\frac{1}{2}$ " to the six (right)

Quilt Top Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for placement and orientation as you add borders to the quilt.

- 6. Sew the Border 1 $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " C3248 Peacock strip to each side of the C3245 Peacock panel. Sew the Border 1 $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 26" C3248 Peacock strips to the top and bottom of the panel. Trim the quilt center to $44\frac{1}{2}$ " x $25\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 7. Sew a Border 2 3" x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " C3247 Beige strip to both sides of the quilt.
- 8. Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the wrong side of the 3\%" C3247 Beige squares. With right sides together, place the marked square on top of a 3\%" C3096 Taupe square. Sew a scant 1/4" on both sides of the marked line. Cut along the drawn line. Repeat with the remaining 3\%" squares, making a total of four 3" half-square triangle units (HST). Matching the Beige side, sew an HST unit to each end of both the Border 2 3" x 25\%" C3247 Beige strips.
- 9. Sew one pieced Beige Border 2 to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt.
- 10. Sew the Border 3 $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $49\frac{1}{2}$ " C3096 Taupe strip to both sides of the quilt. Sew one Border 3 $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{1}{2}$ " C3096 Taupe border to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt.
- 11. Repeat steps 9 and 10 using the Border 4 C3246 Aqua strips and the remaining Border 5 C3096 Taupe strips.
- 12. Sew the pieced star Border 6 sections to the appropriate sides, and then to the top and bottom of the quilt top in the same manner. Note the specific location of each strip.
- 13. Continue adding Borders 7, 8 and 9 in sequence using the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " C3246 Aqua, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " C3096 Taupe and 4" C3248 Peacock strips to complete the quilt top.

Finishing

- 14. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. 15. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
- 16. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.


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Quilt Assembly Diagram
